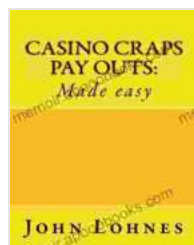

- **Pass Line Bet:** Pays even money (1:1) if the shooter (the player rolling the dice) establishes a point (4, 5, 6, 8, 9, or 10) and wins by rolling the point again before rolling a 7.
- **Don't Pass Line Bet:** Pays even money (1:1) if the shooter fails to establish a point or rolls a 7 before rolling the point.

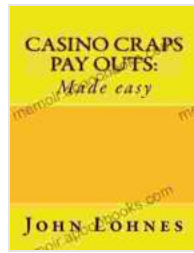

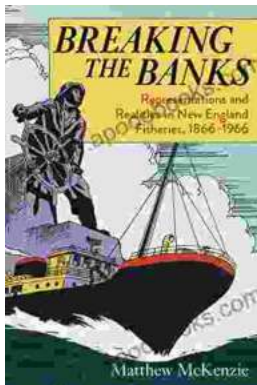
