7. To finish the pattern, stitch the cow's hooves using one strand of black floss.

Tips

- If you're new to cross stitching, I recommend starting with a smaller project. This pattern is a good size for beginners, but if you're feeling overwhelmed, you can always reduce the size of the pattern by stitching it on smaller Aida cloth.

- Be sure to use sharp needles. This will help to prevent your floss from fraying.
- Take your time and enjoy the process. Cross stitching is a great way to relax and de-stress.

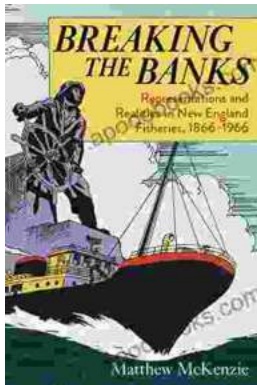
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
